



JAGAM & NDS Scholarship Applications

1. Content

JAGAM & Nippon Designers School Malaysia College is recruiting individuals who are interested pursuing their study in Diploma Manga Illustration (2 years 8 months) and Diploma 3D Animation (2 years 8 months). The class will be commenced in September 2023. Successful applicant will be received either:

- I. Full tuition fee exemption: 1 person **OR**
- II. 1 year tuition fee exemption: 1 person **OR**
- III. 20% discount for 1 year of tuition: 2 persons

2. Period

From July 4th 2023 to August 11th 2023, before 12:00 p.m.

3. Theme

Applicants are required to submit the artwork with the theme of "What does creative mean in your point of view". (For example: You can express it through manga, illustrations, animation, photographs, videos)

The artwork must fulfil the following criteria:

- Must be the applicant's original work.
- Black and white or color artwork is acceptable.
- · Can use any art material or medium.
- Recommended maximum size for physical artwork is A3. Photo images artwork recommended size is 1280x720px. Both in JPG compression / PNG only.
- Recommended duration for animation / video content is between 15 seconds to 3 minutes. 1920x1080px (full HD resolution) MP4 compression.
- For physical artwork, please scan or take a photo of the artwork and send it for applications. Ensure that the image is taken in a brightly lit area and without distortions.
- · If text is used in the artwork, the language used is English.
- Each person is allowed to submit one application only.

4. How to apply

Send in the completed **application form**, **one certified true copy of relevant academic transcript** and **your work** via Google form.

- *Mailing is not accepted.
- *These preparations are not required at the time of application but in later stages.
 - One photocopy of NRIC
 - Portfolio
 - Medical checkup report or supporting documents
 - Enrolment fee of RM500 (non-refundable, non-transferable)

^{*}This does not include other costs like application fees, study trips, student insurance, study materials, and teaching materials.

5. Selection schedule

The screening will be conducted up to two screenings in total.

First screening: Work and Document screening.

Applicants' submission of artwork by the 11th August 2023 will be screened and late entries will not be entertained. Applicants will be informed of the results through email or phone by the 14th August 2023. Successful candidates will need to physically attend a screening with their submitted artwork (physical artwork required where applicable) at Nippon Designers School Malaysia College from 16th to 18th August 2023

Second screening: Interview screening.

The result of the interview screening will be announced to the successful candidates by the 21st August 2023. *Online interviews are also available depending on the situation

6. Eligibility for participation

- I. Possess SPM (minimum pass in BM and Sejarah) with a minimum of three (3) credits in any subject OR
- II. A pass in Sijil Tinggi Persekolahan Malaysia (STPM) with a minimum of Grade C (GP 2.00) in any subject; **OR**
- III. A pass in Sijil Tinggi Agama Malaysia (STAM) with a minimum grade of Maqbul in any subject; OR
- IV. A pass in SKM Level 3/Sijil Vokasional Malaysia (SVM) in relevant field; **OR**
- V. A Certificate (Level 3; MQF) with minimum CGPA of 2.00 or its equivalent; **OR**
- VI. A Pass in Unified Examination Certificate (UEC) with minimum 3 credits (3Bs); OR
- VII. A pass in The General Certificate of Education (GCE) Ordinary Level (O-Level) with minimum 3 credits (3Cs); **OR**
- VIII. A pass in International Baccalaureate (IB) For a 3 credits 23 points above; OR
- IX. Other relevant equivalent qualifications recognized by the Malaysian Government **AND**
- X. Pass an interview or submission of portfolio determined by HEP as required.
 - Malaysian nationality.
 - Applicants enrolling in the Diploma in Manga Illustration or the Diploma in 3D Animation for September 2023 intake.
 - Submission with trial results is acceptable but do note that if the applicant has failed to pass the entry requirements stated above, their scholarship will be withdrawn.

7. Application rules

Regarding application

- Submissions must not contain obscenity, explicit sexual material, nudity, profanity, graphic violence, calls
 or incitement to violence, commercial solicitation or commercial promotion. Content or images that are
 considered abusive, inflammatory, denigrating or disrespectful to sponsors, to any groups, individuals or
 institutions are prohibited.
- Submission must be original content created by the applicant and not any part or content in full that
 contains copyright belonging to third-party intellectual and property rights. Sponsors recognize no
 allowance for "fair use" of copyright material and no allowance made for use of licensed material created
 or owned by a third party.
- Sponsors reserve the right to disqualify at their sole discretion any submissions that do not adhere to the set criteria and the intent and substance of the official rules.
- If the work submitted does not belong to the applicant, the application will be disqualified and eligibility revoked for any future application.

Screening related

- · We will not respond to any questions or inquiries regarding the screening method or selection results.
- NDS Malaysia reserved all rights to make changes without notification.

Acknowledgement by Applicant

- The assignment of the copyright in the artwork submitted is absolute and the applicant acknowledges the he/she assigns to Nippon Designers School Malaysia College (NDS) all copyright in the artwork, being:
